



NO TRESPASS LETTER TO VALLEY LINK TRANSMISSION

It is extremely important that everyone send an official No Trespass notice to Valley Link Transmission immediately. You DO NOT want these people on your land, assessing your property for the purposes of confiscation. Valley Link Transmission **IS NOT** a public utility and does not have the right to enter anyone's property. For them to move this transmission line forward, they **MUST** perform a detailed survey on your property and include that in their submission for approval by the Virginia State Corporation Commission. It's simple, no survey, no approval. If you do NOTHING ELSE, send these letters.

Here are two simple scenarios that illustrate why you don't want them on your property.

1. They survey your property and find out that the corner they were planning to route the line on won't work, instead, they move it closer to your house!
2. You allow a survey but none of your neighbors allow it. Guess where the power line will go?

WHO TO SEND LETTERS TO

The primary letter is sent to the Valley Link Transmission Virginia, LLC registered corporate agent. This letter should be ***sent certified US Mail with a return receipt***. Keep the receipt for proof of notice. This address is:
